Nikitskaya Bordovaya - a cross between American and Asian persimmon combining the larger fruit size of Asian persimmon and greater hardiness of the American parent but only hardy to about -8 degree F. Fruit is orange/red fruit is very sweet and delicious when soft ripe. **Grown in Containers \$30.00 Zone 6**

Kasandra – A Hybrid of **Great wall** Crossed by an F2 Male of Rosseyanka Hybrid back crossed to Virginiana Tested cold hardy to -11 with no evidence of freeze damage a large fruit measuring about 2.50 to 3.00 inches delicious when ripe. Hybridized by **David Lavergne** has a Brix test of 21 and ripens mid-season. Luscious bright green foliage looks like a true Kaki.
